



E.ON was formed in June 2000 by the merger of VEBA and VIAG, two of Germany's largest industrial groups, each with an impressive history in its own right.

VEBA and VIAG were founded in the 1920s to serve as holding companies for state-owned industrial enterprises. Privatized in the 1960s and 1980s, the two corporations were listed in the Dax (the stock index of Germany's top 30 blue chips) and continued their success, now as investor-owned companies. Following the merger, E.ON executed a far-reaching focus strategy and today is Europe's largest investor-owned energy services provider.

E.ON is active in the business areas of power and gas, pursuing an integrated business model on two different levels.

Our business is vertically integrated: We are active in the entire value chain of the power and gas business, from power generation and gas production to distribution and customer sales.

This provides us with many opportunities to optimize our business while minimizing risks.

Our business is horizontally integrated: Power and gas are moving ever closer. Gas will continue to expand as a resource for power generation. It is advantageous for E.ON to be active in both the power and gas business, but it is good for our customers, too, who profit from having one supplier for their power and natural gas needs.
